

MINUTES—SPECIAL HEARING
DAVID CITY PUBLIC SCHOOL BOARD OF EDUCATION
July 9, 2007

Notice of the hearing was given in advance by publication and posting to meet the legal requirements for public notice of meetings. The hearing notice was published in the Banner Press, a publication established for general circulation within the district and posted on the front door of each school building and the David City Post Office. Notice of this hearing was given in advance to all members of the Board of Education. A current copy of the agenda for such hearing was available in the Superintendent's office and on the district's web site. All proceedings of the Board of Education except as may be hereinafter noted, were taken while the convened hearing was open to the attendance of the public.

President Thoendel informed the public that a copy of the Nebraska Open Meeting Law was available for inspection.

I. The hearing was called to order at 7:30 p.m. Present were: Mrs. Carlson, Mr. Otte, Dr. Thoendel, Mrs. Vandenberg and Mr. Hayes. Mrs. Osantowski was absent.

Administrators present were Superintendent Phillips and Principal Bathen. Principal Lentz & Principal Jahde were absent. Also present was Jim Angell and Angie Moore.

II. The purpose of this hearing was to hear support, opposition, criticism, suggestions or observations of taxpayers relating to exceeding the basic applicable allowable growth rate of 2.5% by 1% or up to 3.5% for the 2007-08 budget. No public was present.

III. Superintendent Mr. Phillips gave the rationale of increasing the basic allowable growth rate.

IV. Motion by Mr. Hayes, second by Mrs. Vandenberg to adjourn the hearing at 7:35 p.m.
