

MINUTES—SPECIAL HEARING-TAX REQUEST
DAVID CITY PUBLIC SCHOOL BOARD OF EDUCATION

September 13, 2010

Notice of the hearing was given in advance by publication and/or posting to meet the legal requirements for public notice of hearings. The meeting notice was published in the Banner Press, a publication established for general circulation within the district and posted on the front door of each school building and the David City Post Office. Notice of this hearing was given in advance to all members of the Board of Education. A current copy of the agenda for such hearing was available in the Superintendent's office and on the district's web site. All proceedings of the Board of Education except as may be hereinafter noted, were taken while the convened hearing was open to the attendance of the public.

I. The hearing was called to order at 7:47 p.m. Present were: Dr. Thoendel, Mrs. Carlson, Mrs. Vandenberg, Mrs. Danielson, Mr. Otte and Mrs. Osantowski
Administrators present were Superintendent Phillips, Principal Jahde, Principal Lockyer, and Principal Lentz. Also present was Dee Schatz.

Dr. Thoendel, Board President, informed the public that a copy of the Nebraska Open Meeting Law was available for inspection.

II. The purpose of this hearing was to hear public comment on the David City Public School's tax requests, to discuss such requests, and approve, or modify the district property tax requests for the 2010-2011 school fiscal year.
