

MINUTES—SPECIAL MEETING
DAVID CITY PUBLIC SCHOOL BOARD OF EDUCATION
October 28, 2009

Notice of the meeting was given in advance by publication and/or posting to meet the legal requirements for public notice of meetings. The meeting notice was published in the Banner Press, a publication established for general circulation within the district and posted on the front door of each school building and the David City Post Office. Notice of this meeting was given in advance to all members of the Board of Education. A current copy of the agenda for such meeting was available in the Superintendent's office and on the district's web site. All proceedings of the Board of Education except as may be hereinafter noted, were taken while the convened meeting was open to the attendance of the public.

The meeting was held in the media center of David City High School.

I. The meeting was called to order at 7:32 p.m. Present were: Dr. Thoendel, Mrs. Carlson, Mrs. Vandenberg, Mrs. Osantowski, and Mrs. Danielson. Absent was: Mr. Otte.

Administrators present were Superintendent Phillips, Principal Lentz, and Principal Jahde. Also present were Superintendent/Principal Ray Collins, Prague Public Schools, and Prague Public Schools Board of Education members Marlene Wade, Lori Petrzelka, Michelle Vanek, Dan Codr, and Mike Schaefer.

II. Dr. Thoendel noted the location of the Open Meetings Act.

III. Principal Lentz led the members of the Board of Education in a tour of the High School facility beginning at 6:55 with the group returning to the High School media center for a meeting.

Board President Thoendel led the group in a discussion regarding plans the Board of Education for Prague Public School have discussed in reference to the continuation of a K-12 school and/or major items to be considered in a reorganization plan and how David City Public Schools would view the feasibility of a reorganization.
